- PC/011/26 **Correspondence and emails received.**

Cllr McNamara had received correspondence from Cllr Shaw concerning the temporary arrangements to cover the Parish Clerk's duties. It was agreed it would be discussed in detail at the next meeting.

Cllr Peace asked the Cllrs to report on their areas of Responsibility. Forthcoming actions would now be included in the monthly action point update.
Issues arising : Cllr Hill reported that a Parish Council owned grit bin has been moved to Barrowfield Lane Car Park. Cllrs Hill and Martin to return the bin and ensure the sticker on it is up to date.
Cllr Knight volunteered to take the lead on Harley activities and events. He was already producing a checklist for events organisers and dealing with the Harley Gala paperwork. Cllr McNamara thanked Cllr Knight and agreed that this would be added to his responsibilities.
